Key Stage 2

Each pupil in the Year 6 cohort is equivalent to almost 8% as there are 13 pupils in this cohort. 1 pupil did not sit the tests. Writing is assessed through ongoing teacher assessment which was externally moderated this year.

In 2015 76.9% of pupils made 2 or more levels progress in Reading, 84.6% in Writing and 76.9% in Maths.

In Reading, Writing and Maths 77% achieved combined Level 4 and 23% achieved combined Level 5.
