- *Review our Home-Learning policy and monitor consistencies across classes.
- *Continue to communicate with you regularly via our weekly newsletter and school website. Letters will also be sent home occasionally, usually when a reply slip is required. Paper copies will be available via the school office, website or corridor notice boards.
