- * Non-fiction writing recounts, sequencing events in the correct order, instructions, making minibeast fact booklets.




Mathematics

Physical Development

- * Outdoor Multiskills (Friday).
- * Forest Fun Forest Schools- minibeast hunts, making minibeast homes, natural collages, weaving with natural materials. (Monday).
- * Outdoor learning- gardening, planting from seed, growing flowers and vegetables.



- * Growing our own vegetables and flowers.
- * Finding out about life cycles of a butterfly and frog.

Expressive Arts and Design

- * Role play in The Garden Centre (outdoors) and Minibeast Investigation Lab (indoors).
- * Craft activities- 3D minibeasts, minibeast puppets.
- * Collage pictures of flowers and gardens.
- * Learning about high, middle and low sounds.



Ways in which you can help at home

- * Try to hear your child read daily and learn High Frequency Words (be able to read & **spell** them).
- * Asking your child what day of the week it is.
- * Identify different minibeasts when outside.
- * Record any significant observations of your child's progress (take a photo or scribe what your child has said e.g. ("That spider has got eight legs look! ")
