Free School Meals

If you believe that your child is entitled to Free School Meals, please apply online via the Council's new system: www.oldham.gov.uk/fsm. If your child is in Class 1 or 2 or has a packed lunch, we urge you to still apply as in addition to you receiving the school meal, school also receive additional funding which we can use to help support your child and their learning. Being in receipt of Housing Benefit, Council Tax Reduction, having low income or if you live with your parents (i.e. the child's grandparents) may make you entitled-please apply.

Frosties

We fully understand that for our children who attend Frosties before and after school, the school day can be a long one. We provide breakfast and healthy snacks after school, for those children who want. If you want to send an after school packed lunch in for your child, please can we request that this is a balanced snack and that you help us to reinforce the message that it shouldn't be eaten at morning break.
