### Administration of medicines in Schools

Due to changes in our school policy in relation to the administration of school medicine, staff will no longer be able to administer short-term medication to pupils. If your child requires medication whilst at school, then it is possible to request a 3 dosage medicine from the doctor so that it can be given before and after school and at bedtime. If this isn't possible then an adult will need to come to school to administer the medication at the required time. There are different procedures in place for children who require emergency or long-term medication for example, inhalers, insulin injections etc. We apologise for any inconvenience that this may cause and hope you understand. Please keep your child at home if acutely unwell or infectious.
