RSE Curriculum

At Friezland Primary School we believe PSHCE (Personal, Social, Health and Citizenship Education) is an important part of every child's education. We want all our children to grow into happy, healthy and safe adults, and to learn the skills necessary to help them make the right choices in life. An important part of this curriculum is Relationship and Sex Education (RSE), which will become statutory in primary and secondary schools from September 2020. However, we believe that we already have a well-balanced, age-appropriate program in place. We've recently sent home information on this in a sealed envelope (so that younger children aren't privy to any content that older pupils may access) for your information. In addition to this learning, Y6 pupils will also access a session on puberty, delivered by the School Nurse Team.
