Our current Friezland attendance remains one of the best in the borough currently at 97%. We understand that particularly at this time of year, illness can be common and that sometimes, children are not well enough for school. If your child has a stomach upset, please ensure they remain off school for 48 hours after the last incident as this helps us to reduce infection amongst staff and children.

Please remember, our school bell rings at **8:45am** in order for children to be settled in class and ready to learn at 8:50am. All classes begin with SODA (Start Of the Day Activity) and important messages for the day are also shared. If your child is regularly late for school, they are missing valuable learning and arriving late to class will also disrupt the other children's learning. We appreciate that we are all late sometimes but we thank you for your support in ensuring your child arrives at school promptly and ready to learn.
