<p><b>In response to your feedback:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>*We will share our different reward systems with you through our newsletters so that you are clear about our school systems.</li> <li>*The majority of our letters are archived on our school website. We will use Eduspot (e-mail / text) to communicate as much information as possible with you. Where there are slips to be completed, paper versions are used as not everyone can print at home.</li> <li>*We will explore how we can keep you better informed about the work of our Governing Board- they received excellent feedback at our last Peer Review and Ofsted inspection.</li> <li>*We regularly review the extra-curricular opportunities that we offer our pupils. This can be challenging as we only have a small staff and a small site which we share with Frosties. Last year we introduced lunch time clubs but sometimes there isn't the space to add in further extra activities.</li> <li>*We will continue to nurture and promote a 'love of reading' through a range of initiatives.</li> <li>*We will explore how we can further involve our pupils in fundraising activities.</li> <li>*We are continually developing our systems and the ways in which we discuss pupil progress with you.
