Newly Pierced Ears

In the interests of health and safety, school suggests that the best time for children to have ears pierced is at the beginning of the summer holidays. This gives time for the piercing to heal or to combat infection and allows for ear-rings to be removed for PE and swimming lessons. It also gives children time to practise taking the ear-rings out and putting them back in independently.

However, in such cases where this has not been possible, plasters brought from home must be worn over earrings for PE lessons or those involving any kind of physical activity. The school swimming service does not allow children to wear ear-rings.

It must be recognised that plasters over ears is not a guarantee that during physical work, ear-rings will not be caught or pulled. We therefore ask that you sign this letter to show you understand that accidents may still occur and that you take responsibility for any such accidents.
