Administration of Medicines

Please can we remind you that we are unable to administer most medicines at school. If your child requires short-term medication, please request a three-times-a-day prescription so that it can be administered before/after school and in the evening. Exceptions do apply and we will request a short or long term medicine form is completed by a parent, in advance.

Start of the day...

From next Monday, we will return to all children starting school at 8:45am. We will continue to use the two different entrances and ask that you socially distance with your child(ren) on the playground, prior to the teacher coming to collect them rather than lining them up. The children and staff are all now familiar with their new start of the day routines and additional handwashing and we feel that making this small change will be beneficial for families with siblings without compromising safety.

COVID 19 Updates

Remote learning: For any children who have to self-isolate whilst waiting for COVID test results or following household isolation direction from Public Health, Friezland will support remote learning. Class teachers will make contact via e-mail to explain the learning activities. This learning will not replicate the learning issued if a 'bubble' has to be closed but should support regular learning interactions until your child can return to school. If a child is absent due to illness (of any kind), home learning won't be issued.

Ventilation is **key:** As the weather turns autumnal, please make sure your child has a coatin school as we will still be maximising outdoor learning wherever possible. As windows are typically left open to support ventilation, children can wear their school jumper/cardigan and fleece indoors (school logo or plain navy) in order to avoid feeling the chill!

Track and Trace: When a positive case is identified within our school community, Friezland, Public Health Oldham and a lead LA advisor work together to identify any 'close contacts' and plan the next steps. Please keep school informed of any symptomatic pupils and/or household members so that we can work together to keep everyone safe.

Oldham residents remain under local lock down restrictions- the rule of 6 does not yet apply here.

Frosties

Please remember to send in any booking forms with your child. If you need to change Frostie arrangements at short notice, please ring school as e-mails may not be received in time. Please be aware that if we aren't notified of a cancellation, a £2.50 fee will be added to your account as staffing is based on pupil numbers booked in advance. Remember, Frosties is a pay-in-advance service and debt should not accrue.
