Unfortunately, due to high numbers, any new requests will be considered on a case-by-case basis. As a reminder, if you are able to work from home then your children should be kept at home with you. As with the Christmas break, schools must continue to support **Contact Tracing** over half-term. If your child has been in school and tests positive for COVID 19, you must let us know as it may impact on school bubbles and isolation will apply to ALL close contacts.
