There are still many restrictions in place and as these are slowly lifted over forthcoming weeks, we'll work together to ensure everyone feels safe and is playing their part to reduce the transmission of COVID 19. The remainder of our school year and calendar remains unknown but we'll keep you informed as we approach key dates so that you know what is or isn't happening.



Covid 19 Home testing

You may be aware that from 8th March, households where primary school children are present, can apply for lateral flow test kits in order to test family members for COVID 19 at home, and potentially help to reduce the spread of the virus.
