## COVID 19 Updates

Thank you for continuing to support our school routines and expectations this week. Remember to discourage your child from lining up at the start of the day. Instead they should stand with you in your family bubble in order to minimise adult-to-adult contact. We're making the most of every minute of the day so **arriving at school on time is crucial**, in order to prevent any further loss of learning: our school doors open at 8:45am.

Public Health have updated their guidance for asymptomatic positive cases: If, during your 10- day isolation period you develop symptoms, you should re-start your 10-day count.
