COVID 19 Updates

School will once again support the work of 'Contact Tracing' over the holiday period in order to help reduce the spread of COVID 19. If your child has been in school and tests positive for COVID 19, you must let us know as it may impact on school bubbles and isolation will apply to ALL close contacts. Please e-mail info@friezland.oldham.sch.uk as this in-box will be checked twice daily during the first week of the Easter break. After this time, it is expected that any positive cases will not impact on school bubbles. However, if your child will not be returning on Monday 19th April because of a positive result or being in household isolation, please let us know so that we can record the absence accordingly and support your child with remote learning.



Parent-Teacher Meetings

Unfortunately, the ongoing restrictions mean that our spring term Parent-Teacher meetings cannot be face-to-face. Therefore, as in the autumn term, they will be held virtually using Zoom, with appointments booked via your Eduspot account.
