COVID 19 Updates

School will once again support the work of '<u>Contact</u> <u>Tracing'</u> over the holiday period in order to help reduce the spread of COVID 19. If your child has been in school and tests positive for COVID 19, you must let us know as it may impact on school bubbles and isolation will apply to ALL close contacts. Please try ringing school (AM ONLY) or email <u>info@friezland.oldham.sch.uk</u> as this in box will be checked daily during the first week of the break. After this time, it is expected that any positive cases will not impact on school bubbles. However, if your child will not be returning on Monday 7th June because of a positive result or being in household isolation, please let us know so that we can record the absence accordingly and support your child with remote learning.

CHILDCARE VOUCHERS

Please be aware that childcare vouchers can take up to 10 working days to show in our school account. Please e-mail school when you make a transfer to alert us to the amount and the child(ren)'s account to credit so that we can look out for the payment. Due to the administration time taken to process, we would appreciate block payments rather than smaller more frequent transfers. Please be aware that the vouchers are non-refundable and can't be used as payment towards other services like school dinners. If your child is in Year 6, you may want to monitor your use next term, although we can transfer credit to a younger sibling's account. Thank you for your support.



Eduspot Accounts

For those of you affected by the Eduspot glitches- thanks for your patience and understanding. We believe the system is now running as it should and we've received support from Eduspot to try to avoid similar issues in the future. Thank you for ensuring your Eduspot account is balanced at the end of the half-term.

Please credit your account in advance of using any service. Childcare vouchers can take up to 10 working days to show in our school account and can only be used for FROSTIES.



<u>'Show & Tell'</u>

For classes who take part in a weekly 'Show & Tell', the opportunity allows the child to develop their speaking and listening skills whilst talking to their peers about a memorable achievement or event, and answering any questions their friends may have. As we continue to minimise what is brought to and from school, we have found that using photographs of the event / object has been a much-improved alternative! The photo(s) can be shown on the large class screen and everyone can see at the same time, rather than passing an object around. Some children have even shared the achievement as a PowerPoint.
