Breakfast – 2/3 Morning Activities – Lunch – 2 Afternoon Activities –
Dinner – Evening Activity

FRI

Breakfast – 2/3 Morning Activities – Lunch – Departure

**Amongst this, there will be some free time when children can play games, complete their diary and also visit the tuck shop (at an allocated time). **



MEALS:

The children will have dinner on Wednesday, 3 meals on Thursday and on Friday will have breakfast and a picnic lunch before departure. There are always options for the children to choose from and there are always vegetarian dishes. The portions are plentiful and all allergies are catered for.



SLEEPING ARRANGEMENTS:

There are a range of different buildings at Kingswood with dormitories of different sizes – from 4 per room to 10 per room. Boys and girls have separate dormitories but in the same corridor / block. Staff have single rooms next to the children. There are showers and toilets for boys and girls to use separately. Our accommodation will be allocated close to departure.

PAYMENT:

The cost of the trip will be **£230**. This includes:

- accommodation
- meals
- activities led by qualified instructors
- Coach transport to and from Kingswood (a large percentage of which is kindly paid for by FoF through our fundraising activities)
- Insurance

To reserve a place for your child on the 2022 residential to Kingswood, we require a non-refundable deposit of £60. This will appear in your Eduspot account at the start of the new school year in September and will need to be paid by **Friday 17th September**. We will then set up a payment schedule so that you can spread the remainder of the cost of the residential across the school year.

Please contact myself or Miss Swaby if you have any concerns about covering the cost and we can discuss payment plans with you.



WHAT NOW?

- I will email a letter with the info I have shared in this meeting for your record.
- £60 deposit to pay at the start of the new term.
- Take time to talk to your child about Kingswood, visit the website, click the link to watch the video, give them time to talk about it and think about anything they might need to do over the next year to prepare, eg: have sleepovers to get used to sleeping in a different bed away from home.
