

## Knowledge Mat: *Our Local Area*

<b>Subject Specific Vocabulary</b>	
<b>WORD</b>	<b>DEFINITION</b>
<b>street</b>	A public road in a city, town or village, typically with houses or buildings on one or both sides.
<b>road signs</b>	A road sign gives you information and directions to places or warns you of possible dangers.
<b>office</b>	A building where people work from. Some are large tall buildings and some are very small.
<b>Post office</b>	A place where you buy stamps for your letters and can send your letters and parcels.
<b>supermarket</b>	A place where you buy groceries and other items. They are usually very large and with parking space.
<b>church</b>	A place of worship normally found in every village, town or city. Mosques and temples are similar places for different religions.
<b>map symbol</b>	A small picture on a map to tell you about something. There are symbols for schools, churches, post offices and pubs.
<b>address</b>	Locates exactly where someone lives by having the house number, street, town or city, county and postcode.
<b>postcode</b>	This locates exactly where a building or street is by using letters and numbers.
<b>urban</b>	A busy area which has lots of houses, shops, offices and businesses.
<b>rural</b>	A location in the country. It is not usually as busy as an urban place.



### ***Sticky Knowledge about British villages, towns and cities.***

- A village is usually associated with the countryside and is smaller than a town.
- Friezland is a village in Saddleworth.
- Every street in the country has a name and a post code. The name is usually on a wall or a sign at the beginning of the street.
- There are many signs on the roads to help drivers use the Highway Code properly. There are different shaped signs to help drivers know what to do.
- Manchester is our nearest city and has a population of 2 million 750 thousand people.
- London is our capital city and has a population of more than 8 million.
- Your address has the name of the street you live in, the number or name of your house, the village, town or city you live in and a postcode.
- London is the capital of England, Cardiff is the capital of Wales, Edinburgh is the capital of Scotland and Belfast the capital of Northern Ireland.
- One of the oldest parliaments in the world is situated in London and is called the Houses of Parliament.
