<u>School Dinners</u> Please make sure that school dinners are paid for in advance of the meal being taken by crediting your Eduspot account accordingly. In recent weeks we have had plates left over at

lunchtimes and have had to go and look for children who haven't taken their dinner only to find they have brought a packed lunch that day. If you wish to change your child's usual lunchtime routine, we require two weeks' notice. If your child has also changed their diet preference i.e. become a vegetarian, please contact school so that we are aware and can plan meals accordingly. Please support us by following our school policy. We will be writing to Year 2 families shortly, regarding the move to Year 3 and what this means for lunchtime arrangements.

Industrial Action: NEU Teacher Strikes We have written to families regarding next week's proposed industrial strike action. If negotiations between Union leaders and the Government are successful and the strikes are cancelled, we'll be open to all as normal- we will let you know if anything changes.
