**Eduspot Accounts: Please clear debt** Thank you for ensuring your Eduspot account is balanced by the end of term. If your child is leaving Friezland, we can refund CASH/CREDIT CARD transactions ONLY or we can transfer to a younger sibling. Child-care vouchers can only be transferred to siblings and can't be refunded as they are part of the Government tax-free scheme and can't be used like cash can.
