In response to your feedback:

*We'll continue to welcome you into school for a range of events and activities so that you can see your children's learning experiences, first-hand.

*We will continue to offer a range of visits and visitors for each class, across the school year. We will try to minimise any costs passed to families. As a small school, the residential will remain annual for Y6- it's a fantastic experience but it is a significant cost and staff attending volunteer and give up their own time.

*We'll look to establish a 'wish list' for families to contribute. A great way you can already do this is to donate an Amazon voucher as part of our birthday book scheme! We use the vouchers to buy books for the English scheme of work so we have more copies per class.

*We will explore options for a range of extra-curricular clubs that aren't sport-based. We're only a small staff but we'll offer what we can.

*We will continue to expand our outdoor learning opportunities for all year groups.

*We will continue to share our school dinner menus with families and support children with their meal choices- our fruit and salad bar is well used by most children.

*We will continue to develop the ways in which we effectively communicate the work of our Governing Board to you.

*We're part of the Government's 'Connect the Classroom' scheme and will be receiving a wifi upgrade over the summer. We're looking to invest in further I-Pads/tablets.

*Our children are welcome to use the school field in the morning if they are supervised by a grownup. If our field becomes too muddy, we will ask you not to use it to avoid accidents and minimise the mess in school! Frosties have priority after school, so we ask that you leave promptly after home time. *We are planning our 2023-24 Parent/Carer Workshop offer. We will look at the different topics we can offer and will try to vary the days/times to ensure they are accessible to as many families as possible.
