As the darker nights draw in, Transport for Greater Manchester (TfGM) are reminding road users that it's ever more important to keep an extra eye out for pedestrians on the road as part of their 'Last Steps' campaign. Frighteningly, 25 people in Greater Manchester were tragically killed while crossing the road last year. So, it's vital that children follow road safety rules – especially as they get older and are unaccompanied – and wear clothes that ensure they can be seen in the dark.
