

Children's Mental Health Week



We have had a week of self-reflection, as children have learned to 'know yourself, grow yourself' through Children's Mental Health Week. We have talked about naming and recognising our feelings and knowing what makes us feel different emotions. We have talked about strategies to cope with our feelings and our Wellbeing Champions have introduced special "I want my teacher to know..." boxes into classrooms, so that children always have the option to write, if they can't find the right time or the right words to share their good news or thoughts or worries with us.

At lunchtimes, we have been sitting in our colour teams and, as a result, children have been building friendships with children from different classes who they may not have spent a lot of time with before. We have re-introduced Partner Reading for children in Years 1-6, so that, each Friday, older children have a chance to listen to their younger partner read their reading book and also read a story to them. We finished the week, in our Celebration Assembly, with a reminder of the importance of positive self-talk using this video link.

Key Stage 2 Times Tables Rockstars Competition



Today, children in class 3 and 4 competed against children from all across the UK in a Times Tables speed contest! Our rankings have fluctuated throughout the day, as schools are logging on and participating at different times in the day, but at midday, we were ranked 4th out of 70 schools participating in Greater Manchester... and very excited!

Knowing and being able to recall times tables facts, at speed, is a crucial skill which helps children to be prepared for their Maths learning in Year 5 & 6 and beyond. At the end of Year 4, children complete a national assessment of their times tables knowledge, testing their recall of multiplication and division facts up to 12×12 . At Friezland, we use the TT Rockstars app, alongside lots of other strategies, to help children with their times tables. Any support you can offer at home with learning times tables, through games and songs and practise, is a bonus... so thank you!
