At Friezland, we are always exploring ways to expand our pupil's experiences beyond Friezland, and provide opportinuties for them to experience stretch and challenge in order to achieve their full potential. One of the ways we do this is through our collaborations with other schools, not only our fellow DLP schools, but also Hulme Grammar. This term, we were invited to send 4 children from Year 5 to take part in their "Enquiring Minds" programme; 4 sessions delivered by Hulme's senior school teaching staff specialising in Biology, Chemistry, Physics and Maths, and supported by Hulme's sixth form students. **Mollie, Dylan, Evan** and **Seth** have thoroughly enjoyed their experience, working with children from other schools across the borough, learning about Maths and Science in the 'labs' at Hulme. Staff reported, "They showed a high level practical skills and exemplary behaviour; they were a credit to you and your school."
