Pupils in **Class 3** are currently working really hard to learn their times tables multiplication and division facts. This is one of the key mathematical skills that will help them to confidently tackle the Year 5 & 6 maths curriculum... and beyond! In June, children in **Year 4** will complete the Government's [Multiplication Tables Check](#).
