Oldham Red Watch came to visit Friezland this week as part of Greater Manchester Fire and Rescue service's 'Fire Safety in the Home' campaign. They delivered an interactive assembly to Class 3 and 4 children, teaching about keeping themselves safe at home. Key messages included NOT leaving phones and devices charging overnight, calling 999 for help, staying low in smoke and 'stop, drop & roll' if your clothes catch fire. 
