



Friezland Awards and Certificates:

Team Points – any adult can give team points to any child in school, at any time, for demonstrating our Friezland Expectations. In Friday assembly, the team points are added up and the winning team wins a star. The team with the most stars at the end of the half term get a non-uniform day. All children have a colour badge and we encourage them to wear it on their uniform; staff all have a team badge too!

Learning Badges – every child has a stamp chart (in their team colour) and adults award them a stamp for good effort and good work in their learning. To show this, they draw a star in a circle on their work. This means they can collect a stamp on their chart (usually adults do the stamping, not the children!) The stars are crossed out on work once collected. When children complete HALF the chart, they put it in the box outside Mrs Hammond's office and get a certificate in Friday assembly. When they complete the FULL chart, they receive their badge to wear. The order of badges is: Bronze, Silver, Gold, Ruby, Sapphire, Emerald, Diamond, Special award.

Mathletics Certificates

Mrs Cookson will print out any certificates that the children have earned on Mathletics to be given out in Friday Assembly.

Expectation Award

On Fridays, the teachers give one pupil per class the Expectation Award – a reward for something they have impressed with that week in line with our expectations.

20th Kid and 20th Grown up Nominations

Any child or adult (including parents and visitors) can nominate a '20th' award, to someone who has gone above and beyond. The theory is, 19 people would walk past but the 20th person would stop and help. Nomination slips are on the wall outside Mrs Hammond's office or nominations can be emailed into school by adults.
