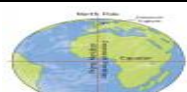

Theme: What's the difference between Greenfield, Oldham and Manchester?

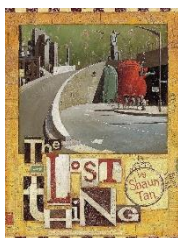


Time Zones
Meridians

Children will describe and understand key aspects of physical and natural features. They will know how to plan a journey within the UK, from Greenfield to Manchester, via different forms of transport using road maps and train planners. Know the difference between living in a city, town or village. We will also be looking at being able to identify the position and significance of the Prime/Greenwich Meridian and time zones.

English:

This half term our writing will be inspired by The Lost Thing, written by Shaun Tan. We will explore meaning and belonging. Children will write their own 'LOST!' adverts, write a non-chronological informative text and also a narrative retelling of the story.



Mathematics:



This half term we will be focussing on Money, Shape, Position/direction and Statistics.

Children in Year 4 will take their 'timetables check' at the beginning of this half term. This is nothing for the children to worry about and they will be familiar with the way that the check works by the time they take it. Please ensure that your child is accessing TTrackstars and completing suggested tasks regularly to better equip them for the challenge.

Science:

This half term we will be learning about **SOUND!** The children will investigate and discover how sounds are made, how sound travels to the ear. They will experiment with the pitch of a sound and find patterns between volume and strength of sounds from the object that produced it. The children will also recognise that a sound will become fainter as the distance from the source of the sound increases.



PE & Games:

This term's PE is Athletics (**Mondays**) and cricket (**Thursday**).
