Class 4: Summer Term 2



I'm a Friezland pupil: How can you get me out of here?

Geography: This term, we will be working on **mapping skills** in Geography. Pupils will become familiar with ordnance survey maps, learning to recognise symbols and read 6-figure grid references. They will learn to use the 8 points of the compass and how to orientate a map. We will carry out fieldwork to record some physical and human features and children will create maps of the local area.

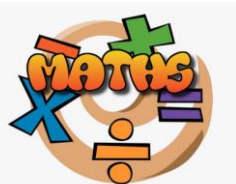


English:

Inspired by the Key Stage 2 production we will be writing a Greek narrative. We will also be using our oracy skills to practice and rehearse the show. We will be consolidating spelling and grammar rules towards the end of the year and continuing to read and work on comprehension.



Maths:



In Maths this half term, we will revisit fractions, decimals and percentages and practice our arithmetic skills.

Science:

This term, pupils will learn about how humans grow and change, including the stages of the human life cycle. They will be introduced to puberty and the physical changes that occur as children develop into adults. Teaching will be scientific, factual, and age-appropriate, helping pupils understand that these changes are a normal part of growing up while supporting their knowledge of health and wellbeing.

PE & Games:

This half term's PE will be **athletics** on **Mondays** and **cricket** on **Thursday**. Please ensure that your child has both indoor and outdoor kit in school at all times. Please provide trainers and pumps and **bobbles** to tie back long hair. Children should remove their **earrings** or bring **plasters** to cover them.

Cross Curricular Learning:

In **PHSE**, we will be exploring ideas of change and loss, which will support the children with managing their feelings towards transition to a new year group or a new school. We will also be covering our Relationships & Sex Education curriculum and there will be a visit from a member of the school nurse team to deliver a puberty talk to Year 6 pupils. In **French**, we will be making maps and practice directions. In **Music**, we are focussing on the end of year performance: Fleeced.
